



Middle School Programme

Discovering Global Issues: Grade 7 Explores the United Nations' SDGs



This month, our Grade 7 students embarked on an exciting educational journey to learn about the **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)** set by the **United Nations**. Through this initiative, they discovered real-world issues that were previously unfamiliar to them, sparking curiosity and critical thinking.

After gaining an understanding of all 17 SDGs, the students became particularly interested in assessing local awareness of both the goals themselves and the specific issues they highlight. To put this into action, they conducted interviews with members of the BINUS community in Surabaya during their Global Perspective lessons.

The students started by formulating questions about the goals they had selected. They then **interviewed a wide range of school members**, from teachers and peers to security personnel and janitors, gathering insights into how well the SDGs are understood within their community.

This hands-on project not only helped students explore global issues but also enhanced their communication skills. They learned how to engage effectively in conversations, explain complex concepts in simple terms, and collect meaningful information from their interviewees' responses.

Through this activity, Grade 7 students are **developing a deeper understanding of the SDGs** while building essential skills in communication, critical thinking, and global awareness, preparing them to become informed and responsible global citizens.





Primary Programme

From Pebbles to Petals: Making Multiplication Fun



Mathematics is a subject we use every day, and at BINUS SCHOOL Surabaya, our students are discovering that learning multiplication can be both practical and enjoyable through hands-on activities.

In one activity called Pebble Grouping, students used pebbles to create groups, allowing them to see multiplication as repeated addition. This tactile approach helped students connect abstract numbers to real objects they could touch, count, and explore.

To further strengthen visual understanding, students participated in Flower of Multiplication, drawing "multiplication flowers" where each petal represented a multiplication fact. This turned math practice into a colorful and creative exercise, fostering imagination while reinforcing mathematical concepts.

Through these engaging activities, students learned that multiplication isn't just numbers on a page, it's a skill they can explore with creativity, teamwork, and curiosity.

By combining hands-on learning with visual and creative approaches, our students are developing a strong foundation in mathematics while having fun along the way.

Math Comes Alive: EY2 Learners Explore Lighter vs Heavier

Our Early Years 2 learners recently brought Math to life outside the classroom, exploring the concepts of lighter vs heavier in a fun, hands-on way. Heading to the Courtyard with excitement, the children began by observing and collecting a variety of objects around them. Guided by their teacher, they sorted the items into groups based on weight, practicing critical thinking, early measurement, and problem-solving skills along the way. The activity continued with a practical comparison using plastic bags filled with different items. Students lifted the bags, shared their observations, and explained which bag was heavier and why. This process not only strengthened their cognitive skills,

but also helped develop fine and gross motor skills, encouraged creativity in thinking, and fostered collaboration and communication.

By transforming the Courtyard into a learning space, the children discovered that Math is everywhere, not just in the classroom. From collecting objects to sharing ideas with friends, this lesson highlighted **the joy of learning through play, exploration, and hands-on engagement**.

Educational, playful, and full of discovery, learning Math outside is a wonderful way for children to grow academically, socially, and creatively!




