The Inaugural Student Council of BINUS SCHOOL Surabaya

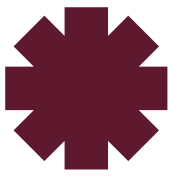
The 2026–2028 Student Council officially took their oath, marking an important milestone as the first Student Council of BINUS SCHOOL Surabaya.

RAISING A GENERATION FOR INDONESIA'S FUTURE



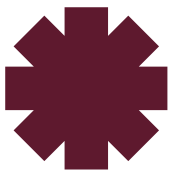

The competition continues. Which House will rise to the top?





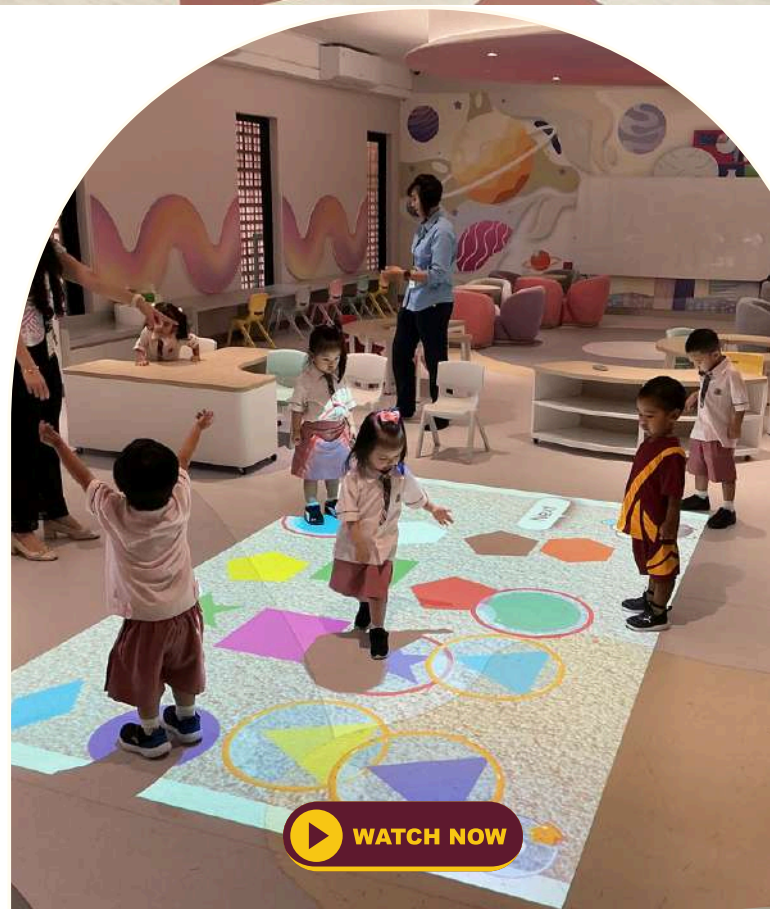
Who We Are: Discovering Our Amazing Bodies and Exploring 2D Shapes!

As part of our “Who We Are” learning journey, our young learners explored themselves and the amazing things their bodies can do!

Through fun, hands-on activities, they discovered different body parts and their functions, explored movement, and reflected on how they have grown from babies to who they are today.

They also became little shape explorers, identifying different 2D shapes through playful activities.

Through play, movement, and exploration, our learners are building confidence, curiosity, and self-awareness while discovering what makes them special!





From Egg to Butterfly: Creating a 3D Life Cycle Diorama



As part of their “Sharing the planet” unit of inquiry, our students enjoyed a creative painting experience while learning about the life cycle of a butterfly. Through creating their own 3D dioramas, they explored the stages of growth from egg to caterpillar, chrysalis, and butterfly.

Using a variety of colours, materials, and painting techniques, students developed their fine motor skills, creativity, and artistic confidence. This hands-on experience encouraged them to make meaningful connections between science and art while showing enthusiasm, focus, and pride in their work.





Exploring the Power of Words through S.T.R.E.A.M.S.



Our students explored majas (figurative language) in Bahasa Indonesia through a S.T.R.E.A.M.S. learning experience. Students discovered how language can create deeper and more imaginative meanings.

Through this process, they developed their Thinking skills by analysing language, identifying patterns, and connecting new knowledge with what they already know.

As Thinkers, our students learned that words are more than just communication. They can shape ideas, create imagery, and express perspectives.



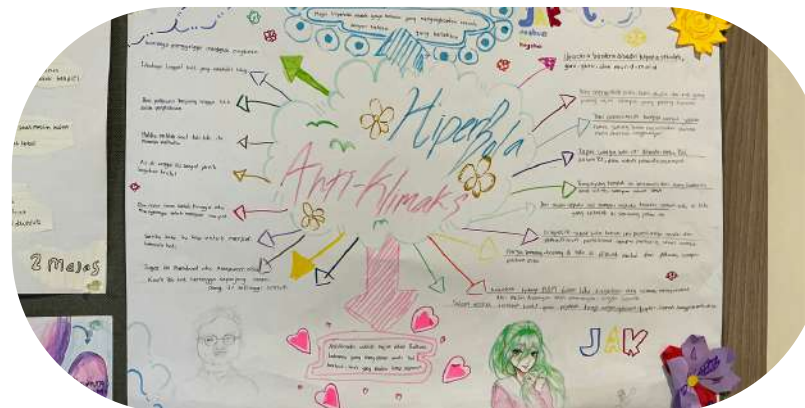
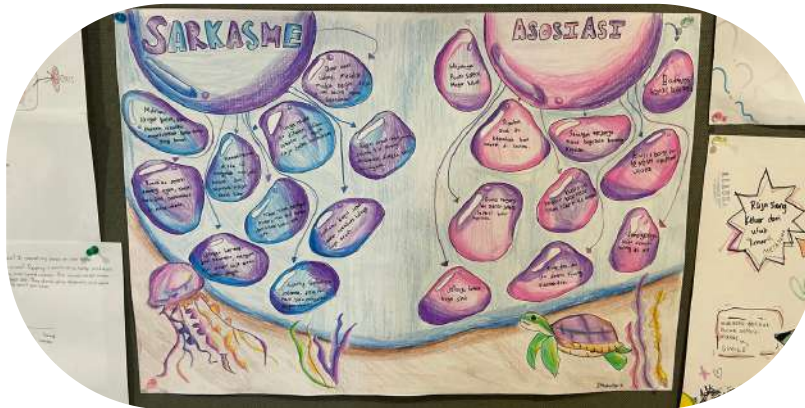
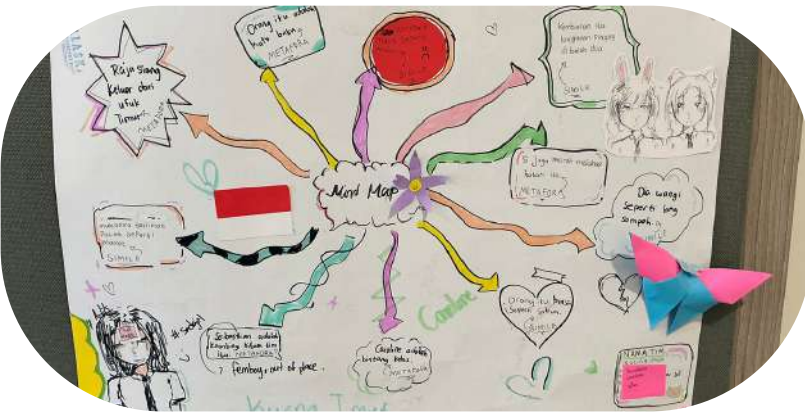


Connecting Through Language and Art

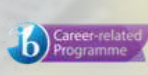
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
